NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO THE PUBLIC AND ALL INTERESTED PERSONS that, on the 5th day of September, 2023, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the County Courthouse, 115 W Main, in Edna, Jackson County, Texas, consideration will be given regarding an increase in the compensation and allowances of the following elected county and precinct officers and action taken to approve such increases.

A public hearing on the proposed FY 2024 budget for Jackson County will be held concurrently and action taken on such budget at the conclusion of the hearing. The FY 2024 budget will raise more revenue than last year’s budget by \$4,327,205 or 40.46% increase from last year’s budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from the new property added to the tax roll this year is \$3,260,260.
