

**RESOLUTION FOR COUNTY OF JACKSON APPROVAL OF**  
**HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS, natural hazards in Jackson County historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) require communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, FEMA requires that communities update hazard mitigation action plans every five (5) years in order to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County of Jackson has assessed the community's potential risks and hazards and is committed to planning for a sustainable community and reducing the long-term consequences of natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update outlines a mitigation vision, goals and objectives; assesses risk from a range of hazards; and identifies risk reduction strategies and actions for hazards that threaten the community; and


WHEREAS, the County of Jackson fully participated in the development of the Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


1. The Jackson County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update is approved in its entirety;
2. The County of Jackson will pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated therein, and will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources, seek to implement the actions contained in the mitigation strategies;
3. The County of Jackson vests with the County Judge the responsibility, authority, and means to inform all parties of this action; assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan Update will be reviewed at least annually; and that any needed adjustments will be presented to the Commissioner's Court for consideration; and
4. The County of Jackson agrees to take such other action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Plan Update and report on progress as required by FEMA and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM).




