Please note that all bids must be received at the designated location by the deadline shown. Bids received after the deadline will not be opened and shall be considered void and unacceptable. Opening is scheduled to be held in the County Auditor's office, 411 N Wells St, Room 201, Edna, Texas.

## **SCOPE OF BID**

- 1. Jackson County is always very conscious and extremely appreciative of the time and effort you must have expended to submit a bid. We would appreciate you indicating on your "NO BID" response any requirements of this bid request which may have influenced your decision to "NO BID."
- 2. Bids are solicited for furnishing the merchandise, supplies, services, and/or equipment set forth in this bid request for a period beginning the date of the contract award until the next award which should be in approximately twelve (12) months (January 2025) in accordance with the following Conditions of Bidding.
- 3. It is our policy not to furnish bid results over the phone. - 4. IT IS UNDERSTOOD that the Commissioners' Court of Jackson County, Texas reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids for any or all products and/or services covered in this bid request and to waive informalities or defects in bids or to accept such bids as it shall deem to be in the best interest of Jackson County.
- 5. The following instructions apply to all bids and become a part of terms and conditions of any bid submitted to Jackson County, unless otherwise specified elsewhere in this bid request. All bidders are required to be informed of these Terms and Conditions and will be held responsible for having done so.

## **TAXES**

1. As a governmental subdivision, Jackson County is exempt from most types of taxes, including but not limited to sales tax, excise tax, and import duties, by law. Jackson County will furnish, upon request, sales tax exemption forms to the bidder that is awarded bid. Bidder shall bear the responsibility of any

sales or use tax if any product or supply is deemed to be taxable by the state. Such costs must not be included in bid prices.

2. JACKSON COUNTY TAXES: If the Bidder subsequently becomes delinquent in the payment of Jackson County taxes that may be grounds for cancellation of the contract. Despite anything to the contrary, if the Bidder is delinquent in payment of Jackson County taxes at the time of invoicing, Contractor assigns any payments to be made under this contract to the Jackson County Tax Assessor-Collector for the payment of delinquent taxes.

## **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. BIDS MUST BE submitted on the enclosed Bid Documents. Each bid shall be placed in a separate sealed envelope, manually signed in ink by a person having authority to bind the firm in a contract, and marked clearly "Delivered Fuel" on the outside as outlined in the specifications.
- 2. Jackson County will evaluate and award bid based on *lowest and best bid meeting specifications*. "Lowest and best" means a bid or offer providing the best value considering associated direct and indirect costs, including transport, maintenance, reliability, life cycle, warranties and customer service after a sale. Jackson County reserves the right to accept and/or reject any/all of the options bid as it deems to be in the best interest of the County.
- 3. The bid award shall be based on, but not necessarily limited to, the following factors:
  - a. Unit price
  - b. Extended price
  - c. Special needs and requirements of The County
  - d. Results of testing samples (if required by The County)
  - e. Delivery
  - f. The County experience with products bid
  - g. Bidder's past performance record with The County.
- 4. Although the cost of products to be provided is an essential part of the bid, The County is not obligated to award a contract on the sole basis of cost but will award to bidder considered to be the best value to the County.

6. Statements of accounts will not be sufficient to warrant payment. Unless other arrangements have been made; all invoices to be paid in full within 30 days after satisfactory delivery of commodities and or services and receipt of invoice at the listed address. Checks will be made payable to the successful vendor only, and shall not include sub-contractor, assignees, or any other party. The county will not be liable for payment of invoices received six (6) months after order completion.

#### **BID INFORMATION**

- The quantities listed are merely estimates of annual usage-not actual order amounts. During the period
  of the purchase contract, the County will buy only the actual quantity required, and it will neither be
  obligated to the purchase of nor limited to the quantities listed. These supplies will only be ordered as
  needed. The purchase contract will be awarded on the date as approved by Jackson County
  Commissioners' Court. The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the one
  deemed most advantageous to the County.
- 2. All bidders shall provide the Brand Name for each type of fuel in the space provided.
- 3. All bidders are required to bid a MARK-UP per gallon for each fuel type and location. The Mark-Up shall include any and all delivery charges and fees that will be billed in addition to the Rack Price and Taxes that are listed. MARK-UP WILL REMAIN CONSTANT THROUGHOUT THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT.
- 4. The County is aware that the Rack Price may vary throughout the term of the contract. Bidders shall note on the bid sheet the method or source that will be used throughout the term of the contract to determine the Rack Price and shall provide a sample copy of any documentation available with their bid. In addition, the vendor shall supply documentation of corresponding rack price with each invoice.
- 5. All fuel tanks currently being used by the Jackson County Precincts are owned by Jackson County. The awarded vendor shall supply the Jackson County Transfer Station & Recycling Center a skid, fuel tank and pump.
- 6. Commissioners have the right to reject, at any time, any material that is undesirable. Jackson County legally accepts delivery of fuel after it is unloaded and approved by Commissioners.
- 7. Loaded weight of truck, trailer and material cannot exceed legal state and county weight limits on road and bridges that approach designated job sites. Bidder shall check with Precinct Commissioner for such limits.
- 8. It is the Bidder's sole responsibility to print and review all pages of the bid document, attachments, questions and responses, addenda, and special notices. The **Affidavit (Exhibit A)** must be completed to include full firm name, mailing address, telephone number, email address, Vendor Tax Identification Number and signed by an authorized representative of the firm. Failure to provide signature on the Affidavit Form renders bid non-responsive.
- 9. All bidders must complete the "Conflict of Interest Questionnaire". (Form CIQ, Exhibit B) Texas Local Government Code chapter 176 requires that any vendor or person who enters or seeks to enter into a contract with a local government entity disclose in the Questionnaire Form CIQ the vendor or person's employment, affiliation, business relationship, family relationship or provision of gifts that might cause a conflict of interest with a local government entity. - 10. Jackson County Commissioners' Court will not consider for action any contract with a business entity unless the business entity submits a Certificate of Interested Parties (Form 1295). A business entity will generate Form 1295 online <u>AFTER</u> notification of award on the bid. The successful bidder must complete the form and submit the signed and notarized form before the contract is executed. ## **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. The Bidder shall not commence work under this contract until all insurance required of the Contractor by this agreement has been documented with a Certificate of Insurance. Such insurance is to be provided at the expense of the Bidder and shall remain inforce until all work under this contract is completed and has been accepted by the County Commissioners'. If for any reason insurance coverage is not kept in force, all deliveries will be stopped until an acceptable Certificate of Insurance is provided to the County. The County Commissioners' should be provided with 30 days advance notice of material changes in coverage or termination of coverage. The County shall be covered as an additional insured and must include a waiver of subrogation in favor of the County. The vendor shall be responsible for any deductions stated in the policy.
- 2. The Bidder shall include all subcontractors as insured under its policies or shall furnish separate certificates of insurance and endorsements for each subcontractor. All coverage for subcontractors shall be subject to all of the requirements under this contract.
- 3. Nothing contained in the insurance requirements shall be construed as limiting the extent of Bidders' responsibility for payment of damages resulting from operations under this contract.
- 4. Any failure of the Bidder to comply with the reporting provisions of the insurance policies shall not affect the coverage provided to the County. The insurance provided by the Bidder shall be primary as respects to the County. Any insurance maintained by the County shall be excess of the Bidder's insurance and shall not contribute to it.
- 5. The Bidder must provide confirmation of *Commercial General Liability* insurance from an insurer licensed to do business in Texas that is financially sound. The insurance should be written with limits of a least \$500,000 per occurrence and an aggregate limit of at least \$1,000,000. The insurance must include coverage for bodily injury, property damage, contractual liability, products and completed operations, and personal injury. The Bidder must promptly notify the County Commissioners if the total incurred losses (as determined by the insurer) reaches 50% or more of the aggregate limit.
- 6. The Bidder, subcontractors and their employees are not to be considered as an "employee" of the County and will not be covered by the County's workers' compensation insurance. The Bidder must provide confirmation of *Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability* insurance from an insurer that is licensed to do business in Texas. The Workers' Compensation insurance should be written with statutory limits of liability. The Employer's Liability insurance should be written with limits of at least \$500,000 each employee for occupational disease.
- 7. The Bidder must provide confirmation of *Commercial Automobile Liability* insurance from an insurer that is licensed to do business in Texas. The insurance should be written with bodily injury and property damage limits of at least \$500,000 combined and should apply in regard to any automobile, including owned, non-owned, hired and borrowed automobiles.
- 8. The Bidder must indemnify, hold harmless and defend the County and its officials and employees for all claims, demands, payments, suits, actions, proceedings, and judgments of every nature and description (including attorney's fees) that are presented, brought or recovered against the County and/or its officials and employees which arise out of an occurrence in connection with the services performed under this contract. The County reserves the right to require the Bidder to provide complete, certified copies of all required policies at any time.

## **SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

- 1. Bidder will be required to notify the County in the event of unforeseen delay arising in the delivery of a specified shipment. In the event a shipment will not arrive at the job site within two (2) hours of designated time the County shall have the right to refuse acceptance of the order.
- 2. Bidder will be required to deliver to all job sites for Jackson County. Bidder will remain on the job with truck and operator as long as required to completely place load.
- 3. The County reserves the right to test any materials delivered at the requested site for compliance with specifications. The bidder will remove immediately from the job site or right of way any materials that are deemed unsatisfactory.
- 4. Safety Data Sheets and Placards must be furnished at the time of delivery as specified by State and Federal Regulations (IF APPLICABLE).
- 5. Any bidder vehicles traveling on County roads will not exceed its legal gross weight.
