## Discuss Covid-19 Disaster and county procedures, and take any necessary action.

Kelly Janica, EOC, reported that Jackson County had reached 14 cases and that there was exposure in two locations and they would be testing and keeping an eye on cases related to that exposure. It was discussed that the Jackson County Memorial Library would open for curbside pickup only. Judge Sklar noted that the Office of Court Administration has ordered no County or District court hearings until June 1<sup>st</sup> with few exceptions. Andy Louderback, Sherriff, requested that the West end entrance to the Courthouse be opened for public access to the Sheriff's Department. It was agreed to wait another week to open the courthouse for public access and address it again at next week's Commissioners' Court.

A motion was made by Judge Sklar, and seconded by Comm. Hunt that the Courthouse would remain closed with the exception of the West end door for public access to the Sherriff's Department, the Services Building will remain closed with the exception of the JP#1 door and the library will provide curbside service only. Motion carried.
