At which time the following proceedings were had:

Invocation and Pledge

Comm. Hunt opened the meeting with prayer and Judge Sklar led the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America.

Kurt Janica, Jackson County ESD #3 Fire Chief, representing Jackson County Volunteer Emergency Communication Service addressed the court in regards to space for communication on the County Tower.

Bubela, to allow Jackson County Volunteer Emergency Communication Service to have a placement on County Tower pending study to determine that placement does not interfere with the Jackson County Sherriff's Department's current placement. Motion carried.

Consider proposed bid for Antenna for the Dome from Victoria Communication Services, and take any necessary action.

Kurt Janica, Jackson County ESD #3 Fire Chief, informed the court of the need for another antenna for the dome.

A motion was made by Comm. Belicek, seconded by Comm. Karl to approve the bid for the dome with EDS #3 providing the labor with spending up to \$1,600.00 for equipment. Motion Carried.
