**Invocation and Pledge**

Comm. Hunt opened the meeting with prayer and Judge Sklar led the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America.

**Discuss Covid-19 Disaster and county procedures, and take any necessary action.**


Judge Sklar opened the special meeting as a brainstorming session following the Governors' newest executive order regarding essential personnel/essential services. It was concluded that it would be at the discretion of Elected Officials and Department Heads as to who was considered essential in each of their respective offices. It was determined that the Jackson County Memorial Library should discontinue its services until further notice. There was further discussion that employees netting more time at work than at home during the Covid event would receive Admin leave/half-time (30 minutes for each hour worked) as compensation that would be available to use within two to three years following the event. The possibility of the County buying back half-time earned was discussed but no dollar amount was approved at this time.

**ADJOURNMENT**


A motion was made by Comm. Belicek, seconded by Comm. Bubela to adjourn at 11:11 a.m.
