PIPELINE PERMIT APPLICATION PACKET INSTRUCTIONS

In order to make sure all regulations for Commercial Development and proper Drainage are being complied with, in association with the Jackson County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance which was signed into effect on February 25th 2013, the Jackson County Commissioners Court determined that it is important that Engineering Plans be reviewed for compliance with Federal, State and County Ordinances and requirements to minimize flood risk and reduce future flood damages and does abide by and follow all regulations under Title 2 Texas Water Code-Water Code Administration, General Provisions, and has adopted the Jackson County Drainage Ordinance on June 23rd, 2014.

On October 10th, 2017 Jackson County entered into agreement with <u>SCHEIBE CONSULTING</u> to perform Drainage Review for commercial structures, including pipelines, platforms, gas wells, or any other type of commercial development within the unincorporated areas of Jackson County. It has been determined to be in the best interests of Jackson County and its inhabitants that the following Drainage Plan Review Fees for Linear Petroleum/Industrial Pipeline Projects are:

- a) \$2,000 for initial review of any petroleum or industrial pipeline project
- b) The initial review fee includes up to (2) rounds of reviews. The same fees for the initial review may apply for any major modifications to the original submittal.
- c) \$500 for the (3^{rd}) , and each subsequent review of plans and submittals.

NOTE: An additional review charge will be levied in the event an additional review of Minor or Major Creek Crossings, Valve Structure and/or Letter of Map Revisions (LOMR) is necessary. The review charge for these additional activities will be in addition to the fee for the Linear Petroleum / Industrial Pipelines. All above review fees are to be paid directly to SCHEIBE CONSULTING. All communication for the initial review will be conducted between Scheibe Consulting and the applicant. Any email communications must also be copied to the Jackson County Permitting Office.

<u>PERMIT AGREEMENT</u> APPLICANT, IN CONSIDERATION THEREOF, AGREES AND BINDS ITSELF AS FOLLOWS (INITIAL EACH BOX):

No. 1	Vicinity Maps, Profile Sheets and Plans will be furnished by the applicant to the County Consulting Engineer with copies provided to JCPIFA office and will provide any other additional documentation requested by the Consulting firm. GPS Coordinates must be provided at each crossing for Riverine, Creek, Road, Drainage Ditch, Public Ditch, etc.	
2	Applicant will bear the entire expense of all necessary reviews both preliminary and additional (if needed) and will pay the County Consulting Engineering Firm directly and pay the JCPIFA office the processing fee of \$320.00.	
3	Upon notification by the County Consulting Engineering firm, the applicant will promptly take all recommendations from the County Consulting Engineer to rectify any deficiency or condition to the Applicant's operations or installation under this permit.	
4	Applicant will install the pipeline(s) in a manner and location as shown in the plans and specifications filed with the JCPIFA and County Contracted Engineer in support of this application for permit. The County Contract Engineer or other such appointed representative may at any time make such inspection as such engineer or other representation may deem necessary to assure that the construction of the pipeline is in accordance with the plans and specifications submitted, and said County Contracted Engineer or representative shall have the right to temporarily suspend Applicant's work if necessary, while such inspection is being made. Should applicant not install the pipeline(s) in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit, Applicant agrees that the JCPIFA Office shall have the right to require, at Applicant's expense, the removal of the pipelines and its replacement in conformance to said plans and specifications and conditions of this permit. JCPIFA may revoke this permit and suspend all work hereunder if it is determined by the JCPIFA Office that the pipeline is not being installed in accordance with such plans and specifications and conditions of this permit. The suspension or revocation of this permit shall not be a basis for a claim for damages against JCPIFA office or any governmental entity associated within Jackson County.	
5	Except in emergency situations where it is necessary to protect life and property, Applicant will not make any change, modification, or alteration in or to the pipeline without first securing a new or amended permit from the JCPIFA Office prior to making any such change and consulting with the County Contracted Engineer for review. All costs associated with any change to the original permit will be the responsibility of the Applicant.	
6	Construction of any pipeline will not begin until all required documentation and payments associated with review fees, and permit fees have been submitted and received by the JCPIFA Office and the Consulting Engineering Firm and the review of the project for proper drainage has been concluded by the Consulting Engineer Firm and all recommendations provided in writing from the Consulting Engineer have been applied to the project.	
7	Applicant binds itself to comply with all Federal, State, and Local Laws or Regulations and will obtain all necessary permits from all Local and Federal Agencies required by law before installation or construction is begun and furnish copies of all Federal and State issued permits with this application.	
8	Applicant will not do, or cause to be done, anything to impede or obstruct an adequate flow of water through or upon the property on/in which the pipelines are to be located or are located; it is specifically understood and agreed that the adequacy of the flow of water referenced herein shall be within the sole discretion of the Jackson County Consulting Engineer.	
9	Jackson County and all governmental offices within shall not be liable or responsible for, and shall be saved and held harmless by Applicant, and further shall be indemnified by Applicant, from and against any and all suits, actions, losses, damages, claims, or liability of any character, type or description, including all expenses of litigation, court costs, attorney's fees, and engineering fees for injury or death to any person, or injury to any property, received or sustained by any person or persons or property, arising out of, or occasioned by, directly or indirectly, the performance of Applicant under this agreement.	
10	Jackson County makes no warranties, expressed or implied, in the granting of this permit; nor does Jackson County purport to grant any property interest or exclusive privileges whatsoever by granting such permit. It is specifically understood that Jackson County nor the County Consulting Engineer is not the agent for, not does it act for a fee for the owners or any persons or entities having any right, or title to possession of the land upon which the Jackson County easement or other property interest is located. Furthermore, in granting this permit Jackson County makes no representation or warranty that it has any property interest, including but not limited to, an easement or right of way, in the land upon which Applicant constructs, maintains, repairs, or modifies the pipeline(s), made the subject of this application, nor does Jackson County make any representation or warranty as to the validity, quality or extent of such property interest, if any. Applicant acknowledges its understanding that Jackson County in granting this permit, does not convey or grant to Applicant any rights, title or interest for which it has no legal authority to grant or convey.	

This Permit Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with regard to the subject matter hereof, and all prior agreements, representations, and negotiations between the parties regarding the subject matter are hereby superseded. When granted, the permit shall not be altered or amended except by an agreement in writing executed by the parties hereto.
